From VP 5, go through the gate and follow the footpath uphill, going west for approximately 700 meters. The viewpoint is located on an elevated, rocky knoll by the Carn an t-Suidhe summit, although the path continues further west. A small lochan is located nearby.




FIGURE 8.40.2 - VP6: Summit by Suidhe Viewpoint, B862




FIGURE 8.40.6 - VP 6: Summit by Suidhe Viewpoint, B862 - Monochrome Analysis This image should be viewed at a comfortable arms length (approx 500mm)
