

### A comparison of two siblings (1076 & 1077)

In 2019 tags 1076 and 1077 were fitted to siblings fledged from the same nest, approximately 10km NE of Granttown-on-Spey. 1076 is a male and 1077 a female. Both dispersed in 2020. 1076 is the fourth latest dispersal we have recorded, dispersing from his natal range in late March. His sibling, dispersed almost two months earlier in late January. Unfortunately the tag fitted to 1076 stopped transmitting in November 2020 with no apparent technical problems. Tag 1077 was still transmitting at the end of 2021.

They visited some of the same places but she ventured much further north. Although, they visited some of the same places it wasn't at the same time; for example, the area 17km east of Ben Macdui.
